

Data protection notice for the Future Packaging Day

Of course, the protection and privacy of your personal data is an important concern for us. In all processing we undertake to respect the principles of lawful data processing. In the following information sheet we will give you an overview of why we collect your data and in what form they are processed.

Greiner Packaging International GmbH, Greinerstraße 70, 4550 Kremsmünster is responsible for data processing. Greiner Packaging remains responsible even if it commissions others (cooperation partners such as a photographer) to carry out certain tasks.

We process personal data on the basis of our legitimate interest (Art. 6 para. 1 lit f GDPR) for the following purposes:

- Planning our event such as resource planning
- Internal documentation of our celebrations
- Internal communication including publication. (Ambient) photos and videos/timelapse videos are published for media follow-up reporting in internal and external print and online media. Please understand that you might exceptionally be recognizable in the course of an ambient shot or snapshot.

For reasons worthy of consideration, you can lodge an objection <u>directly at marketing@greiner-gpi.com</u>.

We process those personal data that we have permissibly received from you based on your (explicit) **consent** (Art. 6 para. 1 lit a GDPR):

- Our photographer will make every effort to make a shooting situation transparent to you and to give you the opportunity to make a conscious decision as to whether we may photograph you.
- CONSENT:
- As far as you give us a clear indication of your action (not turning away, staying at the shooting angle), we consider this as consent to process your photo and publish it on internal and external print and online media.
- You have the right to revoke your consent to the use of your data at any time, without affecting the legality of the processing carried out on the basis of your consent until revocation. If you wish to revoke your consent, please contact <u>marketing@greiner-gpi.com</u> directly.
- However, we would like to point out that Greiner retains the sole right to use the work.

Your given identity and contact data as well as media data will be stored for an unlimited period of time as archive material.

If, despite our obligation to process your data lawfully, there should be an unexpected violation of your right to process your data lawfully, you have the right to file a complaint with the data protection authority of your country. Furthermore, we would like to inform you that you can

- > have the right to request information about which of your data is being processed (see in detail Art 15 GDPR)
- have the right to have your data corrected or deleted, unless justified interests of the data controller outweigh the processing. (see in detail Art 16 GDPR);
- ➢ have the right to restrict the processing of your data (see in detail Art 18 GDPR);
- have the right to object to the processing of your data (see in detail Art 21 GDPR);
- > to exercise the right to transfer data (see in detail Art 20 GDPR)
